The Government of Republic of Srpska has received a grant from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) toward the cost of the Second Solid Waste Management Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Supply of leachate treatment plant with RO method

2. The JP''DEP-OT'' Banja Luka now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for

Supply of a leachate treatment plant with RO method

Implementation period is 6 month

Qualifications requirements include:

(i) Financial Capability

The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence that it meets the following financial requirement(s): The minimum required annual financial turnover for the successful Bidder shall be **EUR 1,000,000** in each year, in the period of the last three years (2010-2012).

(ii) Experience and Technical Capacity

The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence to demonstrate that it meets the following / experience / requirement(s):

- The Bidders shall submit reference lists with not less than **3 (three)** successfully completed contracts during the **last 5 (five) years** for supply and installation of leachate treatment facilities on landfills of similar design and capacity as the installation required under the contract, with a minimum capacity of 50m³/d. The referenced plants shall be presently in operation to the satisfaction of the owner.

- If a Bidder is not a manufacturer, but is offering the Goods, the Bidder must present / submit / with its bid the Manufacturer's Authorization Form (Section IV, Bidding Forms), fully authorized by the Manufacturer.

- At the time of contract signature, the following support capabilities must be included, and the Bidders shall furnish documentary evidence to prove / demonstrate/ technical capacity of its maintenance facility:

- Single service / maintenance facility / fully authorized by manufacturer(s) of the equipment and owned by the bidder, or under contract with an appropriate firm(s),), located within the country. To prove this requirement the bidder will provide documentary evidence (pdf copy) of above contract or statement on possession of own maintenance facility supported with (pdf) copy of court registration to prove scope of works (in this case: service – maintenance of the equipment) The facility must have:

- (i) Employed / or under contract/, at least one certified repair technicians, capable to maintain and/or repair equipment. To prove this the bidder will provide documentary evidence (pdf copy) of certificates / licenses/ of those professionals, and attach it to the bid;

- (ii) The Bidder must demonstrate that it, or its designated sub-contractor service organization, has a spare parts distribution and warehousing system which will provide continuing availability of necessary Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) parts for the range of equipment contained in the Bid so that the needed parts can be shipped from the distribution point/s and be on-site within maximum two weeks from the request.

- Or, as a minimum of above request: Documentary evidence of the Bidder's warranty repair capacity and capability, including certified repair technicians, and spare parts availability; or a detailed plan for establishing the same by the time of delivery. If the Bidder provides a plan it must include a schedule for all steps to establish facilities, staffing plan, locations of offices, and description of office operations.

3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011* ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
